Resolution Steps

Line noise describes random fluctuations/electrical impulses that are carried along with standard AC current

- Florescent lights, appliances, electrical devices, radio stations, or simply working during a lightning storm can produce line noise into your system

What Can Line Noise Do?

- Noise can introduce errors into programs and files
- Hard drive components can be damaged
- Televisions and computer monitors can display interference as static
- Audio systems experience increased distortion levels

- Static or noise on the phone lines will cause slow, unreliable connections, or even prevent you from connecting at all
