Resolution Steps

DVRs may exhibit a slight broadcasting delay from other converters in the house

- Incoming signals are temporarily encoded and copied to the DVR hard drive before the picture is viewed
 - This is called **buffering**, which allows customers the ability to stop, pause, rewind and fast forward live television
- The picture does not appear on the TV until buffering is complete; usually only a few seconds worth of air time
